Welcome to the Toddler Room!

Our goal is to create a safe and nurturing environment that encourages your child to explore and develop their emerging skills. We focus on helping toddlers understand their sense of self, particularly in relation to others, while fostering independence and confidence. Through a variety of positive, hands-on experiences, we aim to build their self-esteem and support their emotional and social growth.

Your child will be cared for by their primary caregiver, with the Lead Teacher overseeing daily operations. The primary caregiver will handle diaper changes, mealtimes, and guide your child during small group activities. This one-on-one care helps your toddler build secure attachments and develop trust with their caregivers.

Each month, you will receive a themed activity calendar featuring fun projects, motor skill activities, and lessons on cultural awareness and diversity. Please be sure to check the bulletin board outside the classroom for important updates, as well as your child's daily sheet and calendar.

As a team, we provide daily exposure to books, songs, and finger plays to support language development and encourage your child to use words. Teachers will model reflective language to expand vocabulary. Through various activities, your child will learn about colors, shapes, numbers, and textures. They will have the freedom to explore and play independently in a safe environment, with plenty of opportunities for both individual play and group activities.

To promote large motor skills, we provide age-appropriate play equipment both indoors and outdoors every day. Your child will enjoy playground time, trail exploration, and courtyard activities, offering exciting and adventurous opportunities. These activities are designed to challenge your child's physical, social, and cognitive abilities, fostering growth in each area. Additionally, we offer daily fine motor activities like Play-Doh, bead-travelers, and latch boards, through both free play and guided teacher-led activities.

In November and May, you will receive a written observation of your child's growth and development from the Lead Teacher, along with the opportunity to schedule a parent-teacher conference. We are always available to meet with you at any time to discuss your child's progress.
